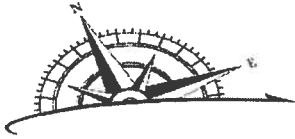

Registration for Student Transportation

Dear Parents:

In order to create and maintain a safe and efficient transportation system, all parents must register their students for transportation services. The "Registration for Student Transportation" form will be used by the Office of Transportation Services to create bus stops and route school buses based on the below school board policies. No additional bus stops will be created contrary to these guidelines. And, no bus stop will be created for students who do not request transportation via this form.

Please complete this form and return it to your student's school no later than June 5 for the upcoming school year. Forms returned after that date will not be guaranteed bus service on the first day of school.

B-27.1 Establishment of Pupil Stops for In-Zone General Education School Bus Routes

1. No school bus route will be established on any road not maintained by the city or state highway department.
2. Pupil stops are designed to be within three-tenths of a mile for elementary students and five-tenths of a mile for secondary students from the place of residence where time restraints, road conditions and vehicle access allows.
3. General education school bus routes will not be established within a cul-de-sac or on a dead end roadway where backing up will be required.
4. No pupil stops will be established in a non-transportation zone.

B-27.2 Establishment of Pupil Stops for Out of Zone Academy, Charter, Alternative, Magnet, Gifted, or Advanced Academic Program School Bus Routes

1. Centralized pick-up and delivery points will be established. Bus stops will only be established at the entrance to neighborhoods/multi-neighborhoods, on main thoroughfares, or at centralized locations within those neighborhoods.
2. Pupil stops are designed to be within a half of a mile for elementary students and 1.5 miles for secondary students from the place of residence where time restraints, road conditions and vehicle access allows.
3. Student enrollment in individual citywide programs/schools will determine the locations of the bus stops in the citywide express route system. Identification of the bus stops will be established after the completion of student enrollment in the citywide programs
4. Students residing within their home school's non-transportation zone will use their home school as their bus stop. If a student did not attend the citywide or academy program they would still be obligated to get to their home school without bus transportation.

B-27.3 Establishment of Pupil Stops for Special Needs School Bus Routes

1. Bus stops for students on Special Needs school buses will be located as close to the student's home as possible barring constraints that restrict safe ingress and egress.
2. All parents of students who require special needs transportation must contact their building administrator to complete a special needs transportation application.

Bus transportation – *the safest form of transportation* – is provided for Virginia Beach City Public Schools' students to and from school based on each school's transportation zone. Staff at your child's school can assist you with determining if your child will ride the bus to school or if you live in a non-transportation zone.

Parents are encouraged to read the Code of Student Conduct as it clearly outlines the conduct for all students while riding a school bus. To ensure the safety of our students, parents should consider sharing "watch" responsibilities with a neighbor so your children have an adult overseeing safety at their bus stops. Parents are encouraged to remind their children of acceptable behavior on a school bus.
